05 Marks

- 1. Every student has to compulsorily undertake a project on Disaster Management.
- 2. The main objectives of giving project work on Disaster Management to the students are to:
 - a. create awareness in them about different disasters, their consequences and management
 - b. prepare them in advance to face such situations
 - c. ensure their participation in disaster mitigation plans
 - d. enable them to create awareness and preparedness amidst the community.
- 3. The project work should also help in enhancing the Life Skills of the students.
- 4. If possible, various forms of art may be integrated in the project work.
- 5. In order to realize the expected objectives completely, it would be required of the Principals / teachers to muster support from various local authorities and organizations like the Disaster Management Authorities, Relief, Rehabilitation and the Disaster Management Departments of the States, Office of the District Magistrate/ Deputy Commissioners, Fire Service, Police, Civil Defense etc. in the area where the school is located.
- 6. The **distribution of marks** over different aspects relating to Project Work is as follows:

- 7. The project carried out by the students should subsequently be shared amongst themselves through interactive sessions such as exhibitions, panel discussions, etc.
- 8. The project prepared should be made from eco-friendly products without incurring too much expenditure.
- 9. The Project Report should be handwritten by the students themselves.
- 10. The record of the project work (internal assessment) should be kept for a period of three months for verification, if any.

Students can select any one topic from the given list:

- Floods
- Drought
- Earthquakes
- Landslides
- Fire

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Guidelines:

- a. The length of project should be 10-15 hand written pages of A4 size.
- b. Credit will be awarded to original drawings, illustrations and creative use of materials.
- c. The learners should constantly discuss with the teacher and prepare a draft before finalizing the report.
- d. A spiral bound project report will be submitted by each student.
- e. The project has to be presented in the given order:
 - i. Cover page containing title, and student information like name, class/section admission number, roll number, session.
 - ii. List of contents with page number.
 - iii. Project overview: purpose, methodology and experience gained in course of doing the project.
 - iv. Chapters with relevant headings.
 - v. Summary/Conclusions/ Suggestions.
 - vi. Bibliography with title, page number referred, author, publisher, year of publication, name of the website with specific link (In case website is referred).
 - vii. Photographs and sketches should be labelled.
 - viii. The last page should contain evaluation sheet.
 - ix. Attached 'Evaluation Pro forma' has to be enclosed as the last attachment in the project file for the purpose of evaluation.
